Legislative Acts

- 1. Regulation, Art. 249 II EC
 - normative act designed to apply to situations in the abstract: "applicable not to a limited identifiable number of persons but rather to categories of persons envisaged both in the abstract and as a whole"
 - applicable without further implementation
 - rights and obligations for States and individuals
- 2. Directive, Art. 249 III EC
 - discretion as to the form and method of implementation
 - addressed to and binding on States
 - requiring implementation before it can be fully effective
- 3. Decision, Art. 249 IV EC
 - individual act designed to be addressed to a specified person or persons
 - force of law, no further implementation required
 - addressed to States and individuals
- 4. Recommendations and opinions
 - no binding force but persuasive authority
- 5. acta sui generis
 - not identified in Art. 249: rules of procedure

Boundary line

- 1. true nature not determined by form but by content and object
 - Case 41–4/70 *International Fruit Co.*: a regulation was found to comprise a 'bundle of decisions'
 - measures may be hybrid
